DETAILS:

- For children entering 3rd to 6th grades
- Cost per week: \$135 for TBHC members (family level or higher); \$150 for non-members
- Camp hours: 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.
- Extended care available from 8 - 9 a.m. and 5 - 5:30 p.m. for an additional fee of \$15 per week
- Camps are led by certified teachers and museum educators.
- Children will explore and learn through hands-on activities, such as games, arts & crafts, gallery experiences, interactions with historians and other experts, and field trips to local historic sites.
- Summer camp registration is handled on a first-come, first-served basis.
- There is a minimum and maximum number of students for each week of camp.
- Please register your child at least two weeks prior to camp. If a session still has openings after that date, registration will remain open until the Friday before the first day of camp.

SCHEDULE OF PROGRAMS

June 21-25: Archaeology Adventures

Become a scientist for a week and dig in to Florida's past! Find out how archaeologists study artifacts to discover what life was like thousands of years ago. Learn about Florida's first people—where they lived, what they fished, planted and ate, and what kinds of tools they used. Try your hand at making a real dug out canoe!

July 5-9: Let's Play!

It's all fun and games this week! Explore games that kids played in the past, from hula hoops and hunt the shoe, to *Connect Four* and *Clue*. Find out what your parents and grandparents used to do for fun. We'll play inside games, sports, and create our own Museum Olympics.

July 12-16: Pioneer Life

Find out what life was like for Florida pioneer families in the late 1800s. What did their homes look like? How did they make a living? What did children do for fun? Travel back in time with us to explore Florida's pioneer days through storytelling, games, and simple crafts. Learn how to churn butter, dip candles, make a quilt and even design and build your own scaled-model cabin.

July 26-30: Museum Mysteries

What happens "behind-the-scenes" at a museum? What do museums collect, and why? Explore the History Center and other museums around town to find out what a curator does, who takes care of the collections, and how exhibits are made. Learn how to handle and analyze artifacts and historic photos. Start your own collection, and get creative by making a mini-museum.

August 2-6: Tampa's Urban Treasures

Explore Tampa's many traditions through a week full of exciting games, creative crafts and field trips to local urban historic gems. Travel by streetcar and water taxi and get a behind-the-scenes pass to the Tampa Theater, Plant Museum, Ybor City Streetcar Depot and much more! Wrap up your week of adventure by making a scrapbook of all your memories as this will be a summer you will never forget!
